CORE SUBJECTS

English

Following the English scheme the children will have weekly spellings and handwriting lessons.

They will also cover;

Fiction & Non-Fiction texts.

Comprehension activities.

Use of language – memorable words and phrases. Reading aloud skills.

Letter, diary and book blurb writing skills.

Nouns, singular & plural, conjunctions, adverbs, pronouns, fronted adverbials, prepositions. Punctuation skills.

Maths.

Mental addition & subtraction of several numbers. Mental multiplication & division, weekly tests. Number & place value, comparing 4 digit numbers. Fractions, ratio & algebra – finding fractions of amounts.

Measurement, tell the time - digital and analogue. Converting cm to mm, kg to g, l to ml. Decimals & percentages - the relationship between tenths and decimals. Problem solving

<u>Science</u>

Magnets and Forces - How different surfaces affect speed, identifying how forces act on different objects, magnet strength and magnet poles.

Animals including humans - Types and amounts of nutrition, types and functions of a skeleton, naming bones and how muscles move.

<u>R.E.</u>

Family - Family trees - where do I come from?

Jesus' family rooted in Scripture. Judaism - Holy Books - The Torah and its importance

Belonging - Baptism and Confirmation. Advent/Christmas – Loving, the gift of love and friendship, the Christmas story.
